CONDENSED MILK FOR CANTEENS AND OTHER CATERING  
ESTABLISHMENTS.

In view of the decision to increase the adult consumers allowance of liquid milk from 2 to  $2\frac{1}{2}$  pints per week, the Ministry of Food has decided to increase the supply of milk to canteens and other catering establishments during the summer months, April to September.

The increase, however, will not be in the form of liquid milk, which will be conserved as much as possible, even during the summer months. Catering establishments will in general, therefore, receive condensed milk for cooking meals at the rate of eighteen  $14\frac{1}{2}$  oz. tins for every 100 main meals per 4-weekly period. Arrangements have been made for supplies of American unsweetened condensed milk to be issued for this purpose.
