NATIONAL MILK AND VITAMIN SCHEMES.

The authorities now held by beneficiaries under the National Milk and Vitamins Schemes which are valid until September 30 will be regarded as valid until November 30, 1942.

Children reaching the age of five during September or October will, however, cease to be eligible for milk under the Schemes at the end of the month in which they reach that age.

Permits for National dried milk expire on September 27. Beneficiaries who remain eligible for National dried milk after that date can have their permits renewed upon application at the Food Office. Those who are no longer eligible for a supply of National dried milk should apply for a liquid milk authority.

Expectant mothers are reminded that they must obtain new medical certificates for milk under the Milk Supply Scheme as their existing ones expire. National Milk Scheme authorities held by expectant mothers will only be regarded as extended for the period covered by the existing medical certificate.

Additional Vitamin coupons will be issued to all beneficiaries. Parents and guardians should call at their local Food Offices as soon as possible to collect the new pages and must take with them the old (4th Edition) ration books containing the existing coupon pages and authorities
