IN MEANTIME MISSION HAD RECEIVED MSG SENT BY FREEZER. MP OFFICER AND INTERPRETER WERE INSTRUCTED TO INQUIRE ABOUT MATTER AT SOV CHECKPOINT. THEY ARRIVED JUST AS FREEZER WAS RELEASED AND BROUGHT ' HIM TO MISSION WITHOUT TALKING TO SOVS.

FREEZER TOLD MISOFFICER ABOVE STORY AND ASKED IF HE COULD BE PUT ON MIL ORDERS TO DRIVE TO FEDREP JUL 4. WAS TOLD THIS COULD NOT BE DONE FOR PRIVATE CIVILIAN TOURIST, BUT WAS ADVISED TO REGISTER WITH MP STATION AT BOTH ENDS OF AUTOBAHN ON WAY OUT. MISSION OFFICER TOLD FREEZER HE DOUBTED THERE WOULD BE FURTHER TROUBLE WITH BORDER GUARDS IF HE FOLLOWED INSTRUCTIONS.

COMMENT: LENGTH OF FREEZER DETENTION MAY HAVE BEEN CAUSE IN PART BY HIS OWN BEHAVIOR, WHICH APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN VERY ADAMANT. WE DO NOT ATTRIBUTE ANY GENERAL SIGNIFICANCE TO EAST GERMAN BEHAVIOR IN THIS CASE. HULICK BT
