A. B. 1 Creating a 20 Minute Time Period for Any U. T. Student to Speak at Assembly Meetings

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To Modify the Students' Association Internal Rules of Procedure:

THAT WOULD ENABLE A 20 MINUTE TIME PERIOD FOR ANY U. T. STUDENT TO SPEAK DURING ASSEMBLY MEETINGS

Be it enacted by the Student Assembly at the University of Texas at Austin that:

SECTION I: Amend Internal Rules (Article ~~II~~^{IV}, Section 2) to include: an "Open Forum" to take place immediately after the "Approval of the Minutes."

SECTION II: Article ~~II~~^{IV}, Section 2 will include a subsection "B" to read as follows: Any University of Texas student will be allowed to speak for up to two minutes each during the "Open Forum." The "Open Forum" will last no longer than twenty minutes.

SECTION III: Article ~~II~~^{IV}, Section 2 will include a subsection "C" to read as follows: A sign-up sheet will be available at the Students' Association office and at the Assembly Meeting. Order of speaking will be determined on a first-come, first-serve basis.

SECTION IV: Any organization voicing concerns to the Assembly shall be allowed no more than one spokesperson per meeting.
