Thank you for sending me a copy of "Cretaceous-Tertiary Boundary in New Jersey, Delaware, and Eastern Maryland." I am very much interested in this problem and am glad to see that it has been tackled so successfully.

Many Coastal Plain stratigraphers in Texas including myself were much disturbed when Olsson came out with his supposedly transitional New Egypt Formation. We thought he had worked with cuttings from wells and not with cores, and cuttings are usually mixed. We did not believe in a transition between Cretaceous and Tertiary strata in the Coastal Plain.
