Dear Dr. Stenzel,

It is a pleasure to report to you on the Bashi Bryozoa.

If you would not have stated the locality and the stratigraphical level in your letter, I would definitely have compared this sample with the Bashi formation of Woods Bluff, Alabama....

There are three species present, viz.:-

- 1) Adeonellopsis magniporosa CANU & BASSLER
- 2) Conopeum wilcoxianicum CANU & BASSLER
- 3) Plagioecia tubifer CANU & BASSLER

of which 1) is by far the most common.

CANU & BASSLER in their 1920 Monograph list a total of 11 species from Woods Bluff, 3 of which are those identified in your sample.

Specimens of all three species are being returned to you by sea mail in a separate parcel.
