**AR. ~~30~~ The Student Government supports the optional inclusion of photo identification as part of our electronic directory information**

WHEREAS: The University of Texas directory information currently available on the internet does not include photo identification.

WHEREAS: FERPA, (Family Education Rights and Privacy Act), includes photo identification as part of its definition of legally attainable directory information.

WHEREAS: The University of Texas has the capabilities of including your photo ID as part of its directory information.

WHEREAS: This option would allow for more convenient access and recognition within the University community.

WHEREAS: According to a Student Government poll, 66% of those participating were in favor of the optional inclusion of photo identification.

BE IT RESOLVED: The Student Government supports the optional inclusion of photo identification as part of our electronic directory information.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Student Government recommends that this option be conducted as an 'opt-in' selection, out of concern for the privacy of students who do not wish to disclose their photo identity on the internet.
