Dear Mr. Blackmar :

The outcrops referred to in your letter of March 13 are outcrops of the limestone (1a) in the Tyus member of the Weches. At those four particular places, that limestone forms extensive flats which are shown in green color, as indicated under the explanation of the Weches. Unfortunately that green turned out very similar to the green of the Emb. That is indeed a printer's mistake. We originally had planned the limestone in blue. You might also look up figure 21 on page 103 of the Leon County bulletin which gives the section exposed at the southernmost of the four limestone flats.
