

Dear Dr. Bennett,

So far I have had no reply from you to the letter I sent a month ago asking you to supply full information about the Pylos inventories. You will doubtless be aware by now that I put a similar request to Blegen who tells me that he has referred the matter to you for your opinion. I have already informed Blegen that I regard this as an unsatisfactory reply and I should like now to express the hope that you will not take much longer to provide the information I ask for.
