

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 4

INTRODUCED BY
SENATOR BORSKY

A RESOLUTION

proposing an amendment to Article IX of the Constitution of the Students' Association, relating to the prohibition of political endorsements by the Students' Association; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS:

Section 1. That Article IX of the Constitution of the Students' Association be amended by adding a Section 9.9 to read:

"9.9 The Students' Association may not make any endorsements in campus or University Cooperative Society elections, or in any elections for local, state or national offices."

Section 2. The foregoing constitutional amendment shall be submitted to a vote of the members of the Students' Association at the General Election to be held the first Wednesday in March, 1987, at which election the ballots shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition: "The Constitutional amendment providing for the prohibition of political endorsements made by the Students' Association."
