PILOT'S FIRST DAY TRIP OVER FRANCE

On his first daylight trip over France an Australian Mosquito pilot of Fighter Command damaged 6 goods trains in the space of 6 minutes on the Paris to Brest railway line this afternoon.

"We had quite a good time over there," he said, "On our way in at night feet French fishermen waved us a greeting."

The pilot, who had never been over France in daylight before, though he had taken part in night operations, came on four of the trains together at a junction.
