In response to your recent letter, ostracodes from the Hurricane Lentil have been listed or described by Raymond Artusy (unpublished Ph. D. dissertation at L.S.U.), who may have data not included in his dissertation in addition to those included. Professor Allan Scott of the University of Texas has worked extensively on the Hurricane Lentil in Texas and may have information on ostracoda; but none of his data have been published so far. Mr. Richard P. Zingula, Humble Oil & Refinery Company at Houston, has done some work on the Hurricane Lentil and may have information for you.
