

A.R. 29 FEE IMPLEMENTATION COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION

TO SUPPORT THE CREATION OF A COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF A MAJORITY OF STUDENTS THAT WOULD MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE ADMINISTRATION ON THE IMPOSITION OF ANY NEW CAMPUS-WIDE FEES

Whereas: A substantial percentage of the tuition and fee bill is compulsory, campus-wide fees; and

Whereas: Students have little or no input concerning how much their fees are or how much money for fees is being spent; and

Whereas: The administration often imposes new fees or fee increases without providing adequate data to support the need for such increases; and

Whereas: The payment of fees is a form of taxation; and

Whereas: Little or no accountability exists to students for the imposition of new fees as administrators are not elected nor are students substantially involved in the ultimate hiring of administrators;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Students' Association supports the creation of a committee composed of a majority of students that would advise the administration on the imposition of any new campus-wide fees.
