Dear Doctor Stenzel:

In reply to your letter of December 26:

I am pleased to know that you and Doctor Sellards will soon come to a decision in regard to the size of the plates to be used in my Navarro monograph. I have been in hopes that you would decide in favor of the quarto size publication. There would be a distinct advantage in arranging the figures on the plates if the large size were used and the cost of reproducing the plates would be materially less. If the octavo size is to be used, I should like, of course, to have the plates as large as that size will stand, but I do not favor having no margin at all.

I am now giving the manuscript a final critical reading and at the same time am having the Museum catalogue numbers assigned to the specimens. As soon as these tasks have been completed I shall prepare and send to you a table of contents and a list of illustrations.
