

A.B.24 Innervisions of Blackness Gospel Choir

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO ASSIST THE INNERVISIONS OF BLACKNESS GOSPEL CHOIR IN HOSTING THEIR ANNUAL COLLEGE DAY; NOW THEREFORE,

Be it enacted the by the Student Assembly that:

SECTION I: The Students' Association will allocate a total of \$375 to the Innervisions Gospel Choir.

SECTION II: The monies will come from the Multicultural Fund.

SECTION III: If any or all of this amount goes unused it will revert back to the appropriate Students' Association account.

Dear Students' Association,

On behalf of Innervisions Gospel Choir, we are formally requesting funds for our annual College Day. For our College Day program, we invite gospel choirs from all over the state. Last year we had 7 colleges attend bringing hundreds of potential minority transfer students. There was also well over 150 U T students in attendance. Although we do not use this event "formally" for recruiting purposes, we do attempt to attract as many potential students as possible by giving them literature about the University and taking them on tours of the campus. The day is filled with seminars that help minority students deal with the pressures of large college campuses as well as an opportunity for Christian singing and fellowship.

Although Innervisions is not considered to be a retention agency, we feel that we do more here to help retain Black students than any other service here at U T. We do this by offering support networks which include study buddies, prayer buddies, fellowship, and we even help out financially when we are able. We also represent U T to large number of potential students by going out to different churches and colleges (in our burnt orange U T robes!) and allowing people to see the type of support organizations that are offered here.

Well all of this has been to say that we think that the entire University benefits from what we do here in Innervisions and we hope that the Students' Association will help us in our endeavor.
