CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR AIR MAIL LETTERS FOR BRITISH  
PRISONERS OF WAR AND INTERNEES IN GERMANY

The Postmaster General announces that to secure the best chance of delivery before Christmas, letters to be sent by air mail to British prisoners of war and civilian internees in German hands should be posted as soon as possible and in any case not later than November 12. The special air mail letter-cards for prisoners of war, sold at Post Offices, price 3d. each, should preferably be used.

As previously announced, Christmas and New Year greetings cards or Calendars may not be sent to prisoners of war and civilian internees in enemy hands; but it is important not to send additional letters during the Christmas season in place of greetings cards.
