AB 4 To Create an Ad Hoc Committee to Investigate Higher Education Funding

Be it enacted by the Assembly of the Student Government at the University of Texas at Austin:

SECTION I: The Assembly calls upon the President of the Student Government to create an Ad-Hoc committee for the purpose of investigating Texas higher education funding. The committee shall be responsible for the following:

- A) Short term: The committee will focus on educating and mobilizing the UT-Austin student body to support several *still-pending* higher education issues (including, but not limited to: HOPE scholarships; and "grand-fathering" the 99-hour rule)
- B) Long term: The committee will offer recommendations for a later, more permanent investigation of Texas higher education funding. This new investigation will be organized after the current 1999 Texas State Legislature adjourns. These recommendations will include, but are not limited to, ideas on how to effectively influence the 2000 Texas city & state elections and also the 2001 Texas Legislature appropriations budget.
- C) The committee will appoint two co-chairs who will coordinate activities and report back to the Assembly as to the committee's progress.
