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AB 1: 2009 – 2010 Assembly Rules (Summary)

Agenda:

Consolidate Executive Board Reports to only what is necessary, rather than all members making a mandatory report every week.

Moved College Council Reports earlier to encourage attendance of Council members.

Committees:

Combine Rules and Internal Affairs into one committee, Internal Affairs, that will hear legislation pertaining to the governing documents of Student Government, and oversee the absence policy.

Combine Finance and Fundraising into one committee, Finance, which will deal with all monetary workings of Student Government.

Rename Outreach to External Affairs to better reflect the duties of the committee.

Introduce Student Affairs, Academic Affairs, and redefine Legislative Policy committee in order to promote active writing of legislation and energetic policy-based committees.

Absences:

Representatives must go before the IA Committee to explain themselves after 3 absences. After 5, the IA Committee will make a recommendation. At this time, the Assembly can choose the appropriate action (Impeachment, forgiveness, etc.). For Agency Directors, the policy is the same except 2 and then 4 absences.

New Member Retreat/ Diversity Symposium:

The mandatory Diversity Symposium is now required to be a part of New Member Retreat.

S.U.R.E Walk Agency

This is now a stand-alone agency with its own director.

Committee Chairs

Executive Board members are no longer the Chairs of committees. They are ex officio members, and Representatives chosen by the Vice President are Chairs.
