AIR MINISTRY AND MINISTRY OF HOME SECURITY COMMUNIQUE

Early this morning about eight enemy fighters attacked a place near the south coast of England. Bombs were also dropped by two other enemy fighters at a place on the south east coast.

At both places, damage and casualties were caused and some people were killed.

Two of the raiders were destroyed, one by our fighters and the other by anti-aircraft gunfire. A third enemy aircraft, a bomber, was shot down into the Channel this afternoon by one of our fighter patrols.
