Dear Dr. Stenzel:

Under separate cover I am returning to you the manuscript and corrected galley proof of our paper and will ask you to forward this on to Dr. Sellards as soon as you have finished with it. Dr. Stenzel requests that we return it as soon as possible. The paper was already in press by the time I received your additional list of references and they are therefore not included. Since the foot notes are numbered consecutively throughout the paper it would obviously make it rather messy to try and insert them at this time as they would have to be referred to as a, b, etc. I think the paper is fairly satisfactory without these additional paleontological references and am therefore omitting them. You will note that I have made several corrections in that portion of the report that you wrote and have also made marginal notes for you to make certain corrections at various places in the proof. On galley page No. 7 there is a reference to Dr. E. W. Berry. As I have said before it is very bad practice to refer to a man and not give the reference and am therefore asking you to insert this reference and change the numbers of the remaining references on galley pages 7 and 8. This will make E. W. Berry equal 36, O. M. Bawl equal 37, Kellogg equal 38, Gardner equal 39.

I shall send the data around Marquez at an early date. If you think I can be of assistance to you I shall be glad to try and arrange to come up and spend a day with you in the field. When do

P. S. At a number of places in your portion of the report I notice that your locations like the locations of many paleontologists are not precise and anyone looking for them would have considerable difficulty. Unfortunately my geological maps of Robertson and Brazos Counties are in San Antonio and some of these locations I am unable to correct. For example Table 1, locality 5, Cedar Creek, 3.25 miles northeast of Edge. Obviously this is a very poor location. I gave you the exact tract and location when we collected fossils here and you will find it in your note book. Please make this correction. Also at the bottom of galley page 7 you refer to a fossil locality "near Edge". Please give tract and survey here to correspond with the location in your table 1, locality 5, galley page 8. By getting your note book you will be able to find this locality. I have made my corrections in red ink and suggest that you use another color so that when the galley is returned with the page proof you will know what corrections you have made.
