On March 25th: we paid off the Ogg-Buffalo Lease block of 7,644
acres, upon which we expect to drill another test within the next
30 or 40 days, and as Mr. Ogg drilled the Pearlstone No. 1 well on
this same block in 1931 to the depth of 4997 feet stopping in the
Austin Chalk; and, which since that time the Shell-Penn-Humble Co.
drilled four wells and the Lone Star Gas Co. drilled five gas and
distillate wells on the Old Shell-Penn-Humble block;

And, in correlating these logs of these wells, with the log
of the Pearlstone No. 1 well, which checks very favorable, Mr. Ogg
decided to make another test there; this block was originally ex-
amined and recommended by DeArcy M. Cashin, formerly with the
Humble Co. as Chief Geologist, and who resigned at the request of
Mr. Ogg and went into business for himself, and who has since,
amassed a large fortune; through his business ability, and, who is
still of the opinion that on this dome, Mr. Ogg has a wonderful
opportunity of developing a good oil field of large potential.
