Dear Mr. Stephenson:

If you go to Smithville, it would probably be advisable for me to go with you so that we can make absolutely certain that the interpretation of the sections and the various beds is correct.

The basalmost part of the Weches is exposed above the riffles and above the water gauge. The main part of the section is exposed at the riffles and the hard bench. The last part of the section is just above the bridge. The 30 feet of the uppermost Weches which are not detailed were measured by plain table from the bridge to the Sparta contact which is a short distance downstream from the bridge. This portion is probably not fossiliferous.

It would be nice to find some marine Yegua and I believe some day we will find the right place for that.
