Dear Mr. Rieke:

I want to thank you for the literature you have furnished me in response to my recent request. Your publications make a substantial contribution to technical literature. I will use and make available to my students the blue-bound document series as well as the pamphlets.

With respect to the six copies of your literature which you state are sent each year to the University of Texas, I have checked with our Geology Library and with Professors Deen and Stenzel. So far as I can learn, none of this material is in our library and has not been available to our students in Geology. Perhaps it has been retained in a Departmental Library, elsewhere on the campus, which is not used by students in geology.

Since we have several hundred students who use the Geology Library regularly, I would like to see your publications there. There should be a copy of each put out for easy access by all, another copy put on reserve and perhaps a copy available for withdrawal in event an advanced student is working on some problem which requires reference to such data.

If you will send any copies you desire in our Library, directly to Prof. E.H. Deen, Chairman or to Dr. H.B. Stenzel, Care of the Geology Library, our students will have the materials made accessible to them.
