

A.R.5 REFUSING TO FUND SISTER SOULJAH

A RESOLUTION

TO DEMAND THAT STUDENT FEES NOT BE UTILIZED IN ANY CAPACITY TO BRING SISTER SOULJAH OR ANY OTHER KNOWN AND BLATANT RACIST TO CAMPUS.

WHEREAS: Sister Souljah's recent public and much publicized statements have clearly revealed her as a racist, and

WHEREAS: there is a near consensus in the public and among civic leaders from President George Bush to Governor Bill Clinton that she is a racist of the most base sort, and

WHEREAS: this body has often and publicly made a firm commitment to the doctrine of multiculturalism, whose definition implicitly if not explicitly includes a tolerance of other races; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN:

that the Students' Association demands that absolutely no student fee money be used to fund bringing Sister Souljah to campus, either by defraying the costs of her visit directly or by serving as capital in order to generate the necessary money; furthermore, the Students' Association also demands that student fee money not be used to fund the bringing to campus of any other unapologetic racist.
