Dear Sir, I am enclosing herewith some gummed labels of the Pleistocene Fossils I recently sent you. I am sorry I had not the labels or classifications at the time I sent to you the shells. The blue card shows how the Museum (Los Angeles) and myself are using them. The white label is same as our L. A. Museum and we private collectors are using them in a general way.

Today, at the L. A. Museum, Dr. Howard R. Hill and Mr. Willatt, who collected them and classified told me that they were positively Pleistocene and that no Pliocene forms had been found whatever.

The gum labels sent will, perhaps, help you in your arrangement. I could, perhaps, if you wish it, send you some 250 of the blue cards, and if you would care to use them, kindly let me know and I will gladly send same.
