INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE NO. 146

The following Joint Communique has been received
in London from India this morning:

The situation on the Arakan front is unchanged. Yesterday, May 25, R.A.F. fighters made several low level attacks on enemy objectives in the Upper Chindwin district. Other aircraft bombed and machine-gunned a Japanese position near Buthidaung and also attacked road transport.

Two of our aircraft are missing.
