

AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 15

Sections to read as follows:

- IV. Access to Macintosh SE would be granted to the Students Association Members for Student Association Business on a first come first serve basis if the computer is not being used by Polis Staff for Polis Business.

- V If for any reason, Polis magazine should no longer require use of the computer, it will be stored and operated by the Students' Association office.

- VI. This Act shall have immediate effect from the date of passage.

All other Sections to remain as they were.

This Amendment was accepted as friendly in the Finance Committee by Senator Nash, Co-Sponsor of the Bill.

The Finance Committee of the Student Senate recomends and encourages the appropriation of 1,000 dollars to go to Senate Bill 17: Entitled Sarah Weddington/Phillis Schefly Debate.

The Finance Committee decided on the amount of 1000 dollars for the following reasons:

The sum of 3000 dollars would deplete the Special Projects fund to the point where it would be very difficult to represent the full Student body for the remainder of the Fall Semester as well as the Spring and Summer Sessions.

With the potential of having a larger amount of more dynamic speakers (this being an election year) it is essential for the Student Association to be fiscally responsible so as to provide the funds for future speakers.

The Student Senate must set a ceiling, not only for present speakers, but for future speakers, and the groups that represent them.

Therefore it is the strong recommendation of the Student Senate Finance Committee to encourage the amount of 1000 dollars only.

We strongly urge Senate debate for the raising or lowering of this amount.
