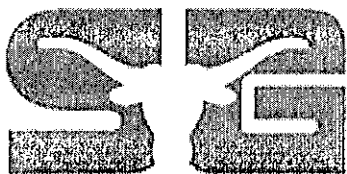

A.R. 19 Endorsing the Implementation of the Establishment of A Dead Day During Each Summer Sessions

Final exam performance is the final determinant of course performance. The creation of a dead day during each summer session would allow students to have a full day for comprehensive review of course material.

WHEREAS: Final exam performance is the final evaluator of course performance.

WHEREAS: Professors require attention to current course work through the last class day.

WHEREAS: A dead day in the summer session would allow students to have a chance for comprehensive review of course material.

WHEREAS: The stress and anxiety arising from the lack of time to prepare for a comprehensive review of course material can cause poor exam performance.

WHEREAS: The fall and spring long semesters have dead days to address these concerns.

WHEREAS: The summer session has not currently addressed this need.

BE IT RESOLVED: That the Student Assembly of the University of Texas at Austin endorses the implementation of a dead day during each summer session in order to allow students to have a full day for comprehensive review of course material and calls for their implementation.
