Enclosed is a letter from Mr. J. B. Dorr which is self explanatory. We would appreciate it if you could get the Bureau data on the wells Dorr mentioned. Please send Dorr, in your own words if you prefer, a brief lithologic description of the 600 feet of beds overlying the Schist in the Luling field and in the two wildcat wells in Guadalupe County if they have been studied by the Bureau. The main lithologic breaks, if any, and any paleontologic data as to age are what we want. If you could send this data in the next few days we would appreciate it.

I received your letter with enclosed map on part of Bastrop County and am very much interested in your results.

I plan to come to Austin Thursday evening, April 22nd, and will talk over your problems and spend a couple of days in the field with you. I will telephone you when I arrive and make arrangements to meet you Friday morning. If it is not too much trouble, would you mind calling the Austin Hotel and reserving a room for me for Thursday and Friday nights? If the Austin is filled up the Alamo will be all right.
