72nd Texas Legislature**

- A student regent position with full attendance rights must be added to each Texas board of regents of higher education institution to provide representation of student concerns.

- TSL opposes the institution of "Flexible" Tuition, whereby the Texas Legislature would relinquish its authority to set tuition levels to the Boards of Regents.

- TSL seeks additional funding for the Educational Opportunity Grant Program section of the Texas College Work/Study & Educational Opportunity Grant Program of 1989 to provide for those geographically disadvantaged students for whom it was created.

- Multicultural education must be instituted as a general curriculum requirement of all public higher education institutions.
