AB 1 Establishing a Summer Coordinating Committee

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

CREATING A COMMITTEE OF ELECTED STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO DISTRIBUTE MONIES AND EXPRESS THE OPINION OF THE STUDENT BODY DURING THE SUMMER SESSION.

Be it Enacted by the Student Assembly of The University of Texas at Austin:

SECTION I: Modify the Internal Rules of Procedure for the Student Government of The University of Texas at Austin by Inserting the following Article and renumbering the following articles:

Article XXI
Summer Coordinating Committee

Section 1: The Student Assembly Summer Coordinating Committee (SCC) shall be established each year for the duration of the Summer Session to coordinate any legislation and allocation of any monies from the Long Session of the Student Assembly.

Section 2: SCC membership shall consist of all voting members of the Student Assembly present in Austin over the Summer Session, and all members of the Executive Branch of Student Government who are present in Austin without vote.

Section 3: A quorum of the SCC shall be five Student Assembly members.

Section 4: All Student Assembly members shall submit to the President of the Student Assembly their intent to be/not to be present in Austin during the Summer Session not later than the last Student Assembly meeting of the Spring Semester.

Section 5: SCC meetings may be called by the Student Government President, who shall assume responsibility for notifying all committee members of the meeting at least 72 hours beforehand. The SCC shall meet no less than twice each month, in June, July, and August.

Section 6: All rules of procedure of the Long Session of the Student Assembly, with the exception of the above stated membership, notification, and quorum requirements, shall apply to the SCC.

Section 7: The President of the Student Assembly shall designate a secretary who shall keep a record of all proceedings and shall submit a report of its actions to the Student Assembly at its first meeting of the Fall Semester.
