William Forbath was recently appointed to the editorial board of Law & History Review; as chair of the Publications Committee of the Law and Society Association; and as chair of a special committee of the American Society for Legal History studying the "Future of Legal History" as a discipline and profession.

Barbara Hines conducted a seminar on immigration law for staff at the Mexican Consulate in Austin, Aug. 24, 2000.

Henry Hu was quoted on Goldman Sachs's role in the merger of Deutsche Telekom and VoiceStream Wireless in the July 31, 2000, Investment Dealers' Digest. **Hu** was quoted in an Aug. 7, 2000, article in TheStreet.com on certain policy aspects of the Securities Investor Protection Corporation. **Hu** was quoted in the July 3, 2000, Investment Dealers' Digest on the convergence of the Republican and Democratic Parties on economic issues and the impact of certain financial developments on the political dialogue.

Susan Klein was quoted extensively on the front page of Lawyers Weekly USA, Aug. 7, 2000, regarding her views on last term's case *Apprendi v. New Jersey*. The President of France, Jacques Chirac, has taken the unusual step of personally promoting **Basil Markesinis** from the rank of Knight of the Order of the Légion d'Honneur to the rank of Knight Officer, in recognition of his work as one of the "most eminent comparatists of modern Europe." The award ceremony will take place in November 2000 in the presence of the presidents of the three French supreme courts and other dignitaries.

Russell Weintraub has been chosen to give the 9th annual Ronald Graveson Memorial Lecture at King's College London, on Nov. 30, 2000. King's College extends the invitation annually to "a distinguished private international lawyer to deliver a lecture on a topic of his or her choice in the field of private international law, preferably with a comparative slant."
