SEC 2: Add Sec. 4.33 to Title II, Article I of The Code of Rules and Procedures as follows:

Sec. 4.33 Social Entrepreneurship Learning Lab Agency (SELL).

- a. Purpose. The purpose of the Social Entrepreneurship Learning Lab (SELL) Agency is to provide education, network, resources and opportunities to students expressing interest in the vast spectrum of social entrepreneurship and social impact. The SELL Agency shall serve as a campus-wide center of all student run initiatives in social entrepreneurship and related fields.
- b. Agency Structure. The SELL Executive Board is led by the SELL Agency Director. The Director will be elected directly by the SELL Executive Board and confirmed by the Student Body President at the same time as the Vice-Director of the Executive Board.
- c. Executive Committee. The SELL Agency is directed, managed and organized by the collective power of the SELL Executive Board, consisting of both elected and appointed positions detailed in the SELL Statement of Organizational Roles.
- d. Members. During each administrative term, the SELL Agency may select fellows based on approval of the SELL Executive Board according to UTSG governing documents.
- e. Strategic Partners. The Student Government Executive Board may elect to induct or terminate all partnerships.
- f. Standing Events.
 - i. The SELL Agency implements a Fellowship program every year for the undergraduate students of the University of Texas at Austin. The Fellowship program provides mentorship, networks, resources, opportunity and training for lifelong knowledge in social impact, lean startup essentials, and vertical-specific knowledge for student fellows
 - ii. In addition, The SELL Agency hosts events throughout the year with various focuses on the promotion of different aspects of social entrepreneurship.

SEC 2: This bill shall be sent to the Dean of Students, the Deputy Advisory to the Dean of Students and the Vice President of Student Affairs. This bill shall take immediate effect until and unless one or more of those entities objects.

SEC 3: The Assembly Clerk shall update the Code of Rules and Procedures and provide an electronic copy to the Communications Director, who shall update the SG website accordingly.
