
The American Association of Petroleum Geologists is forming a subcommittee of the Geologic Names and Correlations Committee to study the nomenclature of the post-Cretaceous of the Gulf Coast of the United States. The recent report of a similar subcommittee on the Permian is generally reported to have been well received and it is hoped that the new subcommittee on the post-Cretaceous will be equally successful.

In order for the work of the subcommittee to be a success it will, of course, be necessary to secure the assistance and hearty cooperation of the several local societies, the Bureau of Economic Geology of Texas, and the several state surveys. With this in mind the South Texas Geological Society has been requested to form a Geologic Names and Correlations Committee to study the post-Cretaceous nomenclature of South Texas and to cooperate with the A.
