Dear Marion,

Many thanks indeed for the information, and I offer apologies for the haste which has sent you to the microfilm without sufficient information. 641 is, I discover, originally S3/1, + 152, photo'd on roll I 43, and in color.

As a matter of fact, on looking back through my concordance book, I find that I need not have bothered you at all, for I had copied out extracts of CWB's book, 1952. It turns out then that 641 was actually the first to come out on Wednesday, June 4; and the second part, S3/152 on Tuesday June 10.

I do have the original negatives of rolls A-Z, and 52-1--52-10, and 54A and 54B, kept in as safe a place as possible. And I would think it a good thing to have all together, and I should like to see those you have, But, I suggest we wait a bit before moving them from one place to another. It happens that I must be finding a job, this Christmas, and that I have no idea where I'll be next year. Certainly not here, in any case. And since where I'll be might make a difference to the best place for the negatives I think it best to wait and see. If it turns out that Cincinnati is, I shall probably bring them out in person along about June, for I have to talk in Oxford in its middle and will visit my family in doing so.

Someday too, I should like very much to have copies of the photos in color of the tablets, but there's no hurry at the moment.
