Dear Dr. Stenzel:

I am planning an extended collecting trip this summer for the University of California to start a comprehensive collection of fossil invertebrates from regions outside California. I hope to visit Texas for a number of days probably in early July, and wish in that time to get as good a lot of Eocene as is possible in a short time. I had tentatively selected the famous localities at Smithville, Alabama Bluff, Burleson Bluff, Moseley's Ferry, and San Augustine as probably the best places to visit. I also note that fairly good collecting in the Wilcox and Jackson is available at Sabinetown Bluff. I should like to know if you know of any better localities than these for me to visit. I would be glad to get some Midway collections also if these are at all convenient to reach.
