Dear Mr. Brice,

I will add a formal note to the letter which Mr. Radford has already written. After careful consideration of your report, my Council wishes to accept your first alternative and to proceed with Scripta Minoa III, even though this may mean considerable additional expense. To deal with the technical details that will be involved, they have nominated a small Committee, consisting of Dr. Ventris, Mr. Radford, Dr. Harden and yourself. I hope that you will be willing to serve us further in this way.

It was the Committee's particular wish that your name should appear with those of Sir Arthur Evans and Sir John Myres on the title page of Scripta Minoa III, and they wish me to thank you most warmly for all the labour that you have put into the work on their behalf.

Either Wednesday 23rd or Wednesday 30th of this month, in the afternoon, would suit Mr. Radford and Dr. Harden. They would also be convenient to Dr. Ventris. Perhaps you will let me know as soon as possible which would suit you best.

May I add that we had not, of course, forgotten your honorarium and perhaps I could have a word about this when the sub-committee next meets. I can arrange to let you have it now if that is what you wish.
