## Student Government Appropriations Application Addendum

### 1. Brief Project Description

Net Impact is a national graduate business school organization committed to encouraging a business school education that incorporates social and ethical responsibility in business. Every year, to promote its mission, the national organization presents a conference that is attended by business school students from across the country. This year the conference is in Washington D.C. on Oct. 25-27<sup>th</sup>.

We have many members of our Net Impact chapter at the McCombs School of Business here at UT that would like to attend the conference. The only barrier is the \$150 registration fee we are required to pay per student attendee.

*This is a pivotal event for UT Austin—a chance for our school to showcase on a national level our commitment to corporate social responsibility, business ethics, and business leaders that serve our Austin community.* This year our conference attendance is more important than ever, because the UT Austin campus has been rated the #1 site for hosting the conference in fall of 2003. We need to send as many students as we can to the D.C. conference this year to better prepare ourselves as hosts in 2003.

### 2. Proposed Funding

\$20 contribution towards the registration fee per student interested in attending the conference.

\$20 contribution x 15 interested students = \$300 requested funding

### 3. Vendors and purchases
