MR. ANTHONY EDEN'S MESSAGE TO BRAZIL

Following is ~~the text of~~ a message from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, Mr. Eden, to the Brazilian Foreign Minister, Dr. Aranha.

From the soil of the Western Hemisphere I send you my cordial greetings on the first anniversary of Brazil's entry into the war. During the past year United Nations have made steady progress towards that victory which will free the world from the dominion of tyranny and fear. Brazil is contributing to hasten the day of deliverance by her active participation in the Battle of the Atlantic and by placing her vast material resources at the disposal of the war effort of the United Nations. I look forward with confidence to the day on which peace will crown the endeavours to which both our countries have dedicated their energies.
