ADD:- Beale is former amateur British heavyweight. He twice fought the German champion - in Hamburg he fought a draw; later, in Berlin, he won the match. "It was in the days when the Nazis were beginning to take their sport seriously; when it was a disgrace for a German to be beaten," Beale told me. "When I was given the decision in Berlin there was polite hand-clapping at the end - that was all. They didn't like seeing their man beaten; they had forgotten then the meaning of the word 'sport'."
