

INDIA JOINT WAR COMMUNIQUE

The following Official Communique was received in London, from India, this morning:

Yesterday, March 7, R.A.F. Blenheims escorted by fighters attacked Auktaungbyin, about 40 miles north of Akyab. Most of the bombs burst on the target and further damage was caused by the fighter escort which made low level attacks before and after the bombing.

Other fighters carried out offensive patrols chiefly over the Akyab area.

From these and other operations one of our aircraft is missing.

Enemy aircraft were over the Rathedaung area yesterday but no reports of casualties or damage have been received.
