WHEREAS, Chin has also abused his power by pursuing his own personal agenda without requesting input from the Student Senate. We believe that Chin should have reached a consensus before declaring the views of the Students' Association, and,

WHEREAS, also in question is Chin's inability to forsee the possible detriment to SA (and therefore students) by shutting doors of communication with the administration, and,

WHEREAS, his undiplomatic and rude attitude in no way cast a favorable light on SA or the eyes of many prospective honor students,
