Despite seeming inactivities on our part with respect to completion of your bivalve volume 3, we have been steadily working on the typescript and illustrations. Specifically, Lavon McCormick has undertaken to check the items (particularly 2-4) listed in your February 4 letter. We need information on other changes before we can get everything organized. I hope that your work on references will not require much more time, and do not think that the section on Morphological Terms should be a taxing chore for you.

Partly because of time which I have been unable to give to Treatise tasks during the last few weeks, it is difficult, if not impossible, to provide you with a survey of missing parts and unsupplied information wanted for the entire oyster volume.

We do propose to assemble all reported errata for Bivalvia Volumes 1 and 2, with intent to publish these at end of Volume 3. We have noted items listed in your 3 December letter for this purpose.
