Enclosed is copy 2 of the manuscript pages 200-260 and page v of the chapter on Oysters. The page v is a replacement for the same page sent to you previously. The pages 200-207 are part of "IV Phylogeny" and need to be combined with the preceding pages. You can go ahead on them. The references are, so I believe, included in those you received previously, but you might check on them.

On the other hand, pages 213-260 are the beginnings of "Classification" and do not belong with the material you already have at hand. Rather, they belong with the "Systematic Descriptions" on which I am laboring now. Please keep pages 213-260 from going to the printer until you receive the "Systematic Descriptions."

I am afraid I cannot help you with the illustrations which you listed in the bottom paragraph of your letter of July 12, 1967. In order to avoid confusion I must stay with one subject at a time. The present subject is systematic descriptions of recalcitrant genera.

You will notice the pages 200-260 show signs of haste and have obvious gaps. Too bad, perhaps there will be time later to correct such things.
