A RESOLUTION

DECLARING SUPPORT FOR THE TEXAS UNION'S ENDEAVORS TO RAISE THE FEE,

WHEREAS: The University of Texas Texas Union is in dire need of electrical, mechanical, plumbing, and safety oriented repairs, and,

WHEREAS: Dr. Ronald Brown, Vice-President for Student Affairs, has recognized these repairs as "justified" and "required," and,

WHEREAS: The Texas Union is an auxiliary enterprise which does not receive funding from The University of Texas or The University of Texas System, and

WHEREAS: The Texas Union does not have the financial resources to pay for the necessary repairs without a fee and fee cap increase, and,

WHEREAS: The Texas Union Board of Directors has acted with deliberate hesitancy to assimilate all of the pertinent information, and possible solutions, and found the fee increase the most acceptable and realistic mechanism by which to finance the repairs,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT ASSEMBLY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS, that this Students' Assembly support the Texas Union's endeavors to raise the fee and fee cap to properly and safely repair the Union building.
