We are having a fine visit in Czechoslovakia in Bratislava and now Prague where I am working with Dr. Pokorny. Your letter arrived 10 minutes before I left work Saturday morning last week before leaving on vacation. While in Rome I was able to purchase what I consider a very lovely (dark green) nylon (with wool lining) wind breaker primarily designed for skiing. Very light and very warm and very reasonable..about 14.50 dollars (I am enclosing the receipt for 8,650 lire). If you wish you can send a check to me at the University in Stockholm where I shall be for 2 weeks beginning December 3 or to Libya where we return on December 15.

I have had a very fruitful visit thus far and obtained much valuable material for my work. No oysters here, however. No specialists and in general not much material I have been told. I shall look out in Russia again but think we have exhausted the market there. Perhaps Poland will turn up something of interest. We go there tomorrow.
