**Zhou Bin's Business Partners**

- Dai Xiaoming** (Sichuan Native): Zhou Bin helped Dai secure Pengzhou project.
- Guo Yongxiang** (Beijing Native): Colluded with Wu Bing and Zhou Bin on hydropower projects in Sichuan.
- Wu Bing** (Jiangsu Native): Businessman, invested in hydropower projects in Sichuan with Zhou Bin; chairman of Zhongxu Limited.
- Liu Han** (Other): Chairman of Sichuan Hanlong Company. Bought tourism assets from Zhou Bin; ran criminal gang.

**Liu Han's Network in Sichuan**

- Zhou Bin** (Beijing Native): Connected to Liu Han.
- Li Chongxi** (Sichuan Native): Sold Sichuan mining rights to Liu Han, whose company generated massive profits off these mines.
- Tan Li** (Sichuan Native): Tan Li, Mianyang mayor, received gifts from Liu Han in exchange for lucrative business deals.
- PSB Officials** (Sichuan Native): Liu Han has ties to PSB officials in Mianyang, Deyang, and across the province, giving him political protection.

**Controlled Beijing Honghan; shareholder of Hongfeng Potash mines in Sichuan, owned Audi dealer in Jiangsu; involved in over 37 corporations w/ Zhou Feng; tied to Li Hualin and Kunlun Energy**

**Chairman of Beijing Honghan; shareholder of Hongfeng Potash mines in Sichuan; controlled real estate projects in Chengdu involved in over 37 corporations w/ Zhou Lingying**

- Zhou Lingying** (Sichuan Native): Sister-in-Law of Zhou Yongkang.
- Zhou Feng** (Sichuan Native): Nephew of Zhou Yongkang.

**Colluded on real estate project w/ Feng in Chengdu**

**Sun Jiancheng** (Sichuan Native): Deputy Chief of Wuxi Land and Resources Bureau; travelled back and forth to visit Zhou Yonakang.

**Established A Business Selling Wuliangye Liquor in Jiangsu; Deceased**

- Zhou Yuanqing** (Sichuan Native): Brother of Zhou Yongkang.
- Zhou Yuanxing** (Sichuan Native): Brother of Zhou Yongkang.

**Zhou Bin's wife, who managed many of his companies, including Beijing Zhongxu; Also started a TV production company**

**Zhan Minli, Zhou Feng's mother-in-law, lives in Southern California and holds ownership in many—some reports indicate at least nine—of Zhou Bin's business ventures; she is an American citizen**

- Huang Wan** (Sichuan Native): Daughter-in-Law of Zhou Yongkang.
- Zhan Minli** (Other): Mother-in-Law of Zhou Bin.

**Zhou Yongkang**  
Politburo Standing Committee Member

**Major Zhou Surrogates/Secretaries in Sichuan**

- Guo Yongxiang** (Beijing Native): Former Chairman of Beijing Zhongxu Yangguang Petroleum and Natural Gas Tech.; controls several corps. in China.
- Li Chongxi** (Sichuan Native): Former Deputy Party Secretary of China; served under Zhou Yongkang; maintained a close relationship with Liu Han.
- Li Chuncheng** (Sichuan Native): Mayor of Chengdu; worked under Zhou Yongkang; controlled a vast network of officials in Sichuan.

**Major Zhou Allies at the CNPC**

- Jiang Jiemin** (Sichuan Native): Former president of CNPC, involved in the Pengzhou project.
- Li Hualin** (Sichuan Native): Kunlun Energy leader, tied to Zhou Lingying.

**Zhou Ally in Security System**

- Li Dongsheng** (Sichuan Native): Vice Minister of Public Security, close to Zhou, connected to Ding Xuefeng in Shanxi province.

**Li Chuncheng's Network in Sichuan**

- Cao Yongzheng** (Sichuan Native): A soothsayer, who advised Li on urban projects;
- Wu Tao** (Sichuan Native): Head of PSB in Jinjiang District, Chengdu, gave Li illegal passports.
- Deng Hong** (Sichuan Native): Head of ETG, colluded on real estate projects with Li.
- Wang Junlin** (Sichuan Native): Colluded on real estate projects with Li.
- Ping Xing** (Sichuan Native): Head of Chengdu HT Corp., received preferential treatment from Li on real estate.
- Dai Xiaoming** (Sichuan Native): Head of Chengdu Industry, colluded with Li on an oil project.
- He Huazhang** (Sichuan Native): Ran Chengdu's propaganda Dept.
