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AB 3: To create an appointed position within the Student Government for a Resident Assistant Advisor to the Division of Housing and Food.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To modify the Internal Rules of Procedure for the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin:

Section I: Amend the Internal Rules and Procedures for the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin by inserting the following after Article \_\_\_ and renumbering the following articles:

Article \_\_\_

Resident Assistant Advisor to the Division of Housing and Food

Section 1: The purpose of the Resident Assistant Advisor to the Division of Housing and Food at the University of Texas at Austin is to better establish communication between resident assistants and the Division of Housing and Food, to create a resource to disseminate information out to resident assistants, to act as a voice for resident assistants to the university community, and serve as a liaison between the Division of Housing and Food and resident assistants.

Section 2: The Resident Assistant Advisor, prior to appointment, must be hired as a Resident Assistant at the University of Texas at Austin and maintain that employment for the entire term for which they are appointed.

Section 3: The Resident Assistant Advisor will be appointed by the President of the Student Government of the University of Texas at Austin and confirmed by a majority of the Student Assembly.

Section 4: The term of the Resident Assistant Advisor shall be one year, eligible for reappointment.

Section 5: The Resident Assistant Advisor will attend at least one meeting a month with the Assistant Director of Residence Life, the President of the University Residence Hall Association, and the Student Government appointee to the University Residence Hall Association.

Section 6: If the Resident Assistant Advisor fails to perform the duties of the appointment or has their employment terminated as a Resident Assistant by the Division of Housing and Food, that upon the approval of a two-thirds majority of the Student Assembly, they will be removed from the position and a new advisor be appointed by the Student Government

President of the University of Texas at Austin following the same procedure as originally stated in Section 3 of this article.
