May 31.


Ambassador Petre Balaceanu (Bah-lach-YAN-oo) will make a brief farewell call at 5:30 PM, Wednesday, May 31. A brief biography is at Tab A.

You may wish to say:

- You would like to see continued improvement in relations between the United States and Romania;
- We are pleased that Romania is participating in the Water for Peace Conference (the only Warsaw Pact country to do so). We hope there will be increasingly active exchanges of experience and ideas in all fields.

Balaceanu may ask about prospects for the East-West trade bill (Romania is anxious for MFN).

The Ambassador will be accompanied by Walter Stoessel, Deputy Assistant Secretary for European Affairs. I will be standing by.
