
Dear Henry:

I have immediate use for them.

Frank Lozo is correct in believing that it will forever be impossible to be sure of the type locality for Gryphaea pitcheri and Gryphaea corrugata. We think that Gryphaea pitcheri came from the Fort Worth rocks about 3 miles south of Fort Towson, and that Gryphaea corrugata possibly came from the rocks associated with the Goodland limestone near the present town of Goode.

I have talked to Bob Fay about your desire for oyster material and he will no doubt send you some of his collection.
